



From “Participant” to “Partner”

Pinnacle Forum is an invitation-only, national network of influential Christian leaders. Such leaders are typically introduced to Pinnacle Forum through personal referrals, attendance at what are known as “Introduction Meetings,” or through connections on platforms such as Linked In.

A leader who has been introduced to the concept of Pinnacle Forum, and who is interested in learning more, is usually invited to visit a Forum. This is an opportunity for this person to “kick the tires,” to see first-hand if the Forum experience is a good fit at this time of his or her life.

At this stage we identify this person as a “Participant.”

After a period of about two months, or four to eight meetings, the Participant is then invited to become a Partner. If the Participant agrees, the next step is to fill out a Partner Application, or “Commitment” form. This application includes:

- 1) Six criteria, of which the Participant needs to meet four, in order to be accepted as a Partner.
- 2) The requirement that the new Partner affirm Pinnacle Forum’s Statement of Faith.
- 3) An agreement to commit to 100% confidentiality in the Forum; to advance the Pinnacle Forum mission of personal and cultural transformation; to not use Pinnacle Forum as a means to self-promote one’s business or organization; and to give at least \$100 per month, or \$1,200 per year, to support the national and chapter Pinnacle Forum movement.
