Prior to launching Love & Truth Network, he served as the pastor of Soul-Care Ministries, working on a pastoral team of a large church in upstate NY for twelve years.

Garry has also served as the director of Transforming Congregations (UMC), a renewal ministry formed in 1988 by a group of Methodist pastors who were deeply concerned about the growing impact of sexual brokenness, confusion about identity and human sexuality, and the great need for The United Methodist Church to develop an effective equipping ministry, promoting both radical love and solid scriptural truth.

Garry was once a gay-identified man who personally understands that God is still transforming lives and setting captives free. He has been married to Melissa Ingraham (LMHC) for more than 12 years, and are the parents of two young boys. They are based in Phoenix AZ and serve to promote relational & sexual wholeness through leadership team meetings and a variety of teaching, preaching, conferences and ministry opportunities across the country.
