

Terry A. Hamlin – BIO

Terry is currently 74 years old. Looking back over his long work career in business, industry, government he sees the Lord's involvement in his life. The Lord developed a unique breadth of experience, knowledge and background. The Lord had prepared him even during unbelieving life by providing a broad range of personal experience in communications, community relations, public affairs, media relations, government and marketing. The Holy Spirit had uniquely prepared him to serve in ministry. God called him into personal ministry in 1992 and to serve with Pinnacle Forum in 1994.

His love for his Lord Jesus Christ along with a personal passion for sharing the gospel message through evangelism and discipleship, led him in later years to pursue a broader theological understanding. He attained master's degree in Graduate Theology and Evangelism through the Londen Institute and is an ordained Pastor.

Terry grew up on a small farm in western Colorado. After obtaining degrees in sociology, economics and education at Mesa and Western State Universities, he pursued a ten-year career in Colorado's ski industry, where he was involved in ski area operations as ski patrol director. Then serving in a variety of management positions including Director of Marketing services and planning for the Crested Butte Mountain Resort. Running for public office and active in community affairs he served as Director and Treasurer of the Crested Butte Water and Sanitation District. There becoming familiar with local governments by helping incorporate in 1974 the new ski resort town of Mt. Crested Butte, then later serving that community as Councilman and Mayor. He was also a real estate Broker as was Becky together they founded Becky Hamlin Realty serving real estate needs in Gunnison County. He also utilized experience first as a volunteer for FEMA and later as a paid consultant teacher on natural disasters.

In the early 1980's he was employed as manager of local affairs, government affairs and public relations for AMAX, Inc., a Fortune 500 international mining company, now a subsidiary of Phelps-Dodge. There he organized and directed public relations, community relations and government relations for proposed

mineral development projects and served as the Chairman of the Public Affairs Committee of the Colorado Mining Association.

Relocating to Arizona in 1987, he was employed in the golf industry as Vice President of Marketing for the John Jacobs Golf Companies. From 1994 until 2008 he has served as an initiator, facilitator with others becoming in 2000 Executive Director of Pinnacle Forum Arizona, a faith-based outreach to men and women in leadership envisioned by Dr. Bill Bright.

Becky his wife, now of 50 years was actively engaged in the ministry, organizing, and initiating the Pinnacle Forum Arizona Women's ministry. Together they have two grown sons Jason (50) and his wife Anissa and Zachery (49) and his wife Denise.

Terry and Becky remain active in serving Jesus continuing to study His word and evangelize. They have founded with others Bible Studies, Bible believing churches continuing to help found, fund and encourage new scriptural ministry endeavors.
