

Michael J. Mobley, Ph.D. – BIO

Dr. Michael Mobley has eclectic experience as a scientist, corporate executive, academic, entrepreneur, and ministry leader. He now serves as the COO for the Galilean Institute.

Mobley obtained an M.S. in Chemical Physics from Simon Fraser University, British Columbia, and a Ph.D. in Physical Chemistry from Arizona State University.

Starting in industry, Mobley held executive positions with the Procter & Gamble Company, including 9 years as Director of R&D for 2 Divisions.

Transitioning to academia, Mobley became Associate Director of the Biodesign Institute at Arizona State University and was responsible for startup operations of this flagship research initiative.

Later joining Grand Canyon University, a private Christian university, Mobley served as Professor and Executive Director for the Office for Research and Innovation and was responsible for the startup and curriculum design of the new engineering school. He continues to publish in foundational physics and optics.

He has also served as a community leader, chairing the Arizona BioIndustry Association for 2 years.

As an entrepreneur, Mobley invented the StayKlear Multi-Care Hand Sanitizer Lotion launched in 2021 in response to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Having made a Christian commitment in 1975, Mobley has served in churches in many capacities – as Bible study teacher, Bible camps director, youth program leader, deacon, missions committee head, worship leader, Christian faculty leader, and occasional preacher. He also serves as coordinator for the 2033 Global Communications Network that is preparing for the bimillennial of the resurrection.

Mobley has been married to his wife, Kathryn, for over 50 years and they've raised 3 children and have 7 grandchildren. The Mobley's reside in Phoenix, Arizona.
